Other than a few native libraries, everything is Java source that can be built on any supported platform with the included GWT [Ant](#) build files. GWT emphasizes [reusable](#), efficient approaches to common web development tasks, namely [asynchronous remote procedure calls](#), history management, [bookmarking](#), [UI](#) abstraction, [internationalization](#), and [cross-browser portability](#).
